Janice MacKinnon is a professor of fiscal policy at the University of Saskatchewan, Chair of Canada's Economic Advisory Council, as well as Chair of the Institute for Research on Public Policy (IRPP), a federally endowed Montreal-based research institute, and Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada. She has an honours B.A. from the University of Western Ontario and a M.A. and PhD from Queen's.

Between 1991 and 2001 she was a cabinet minister in Saskatchewan and held various portfolios including Minister of Finance, Minister of Social Services, Minister of Economic Development, and Government House leader. During her tenure as Finance Minister, Saskatchewan became the first government in Canada to balance its budget in the 1990s.

She is the author of three books, [The Liberty We Seek](#) published by Harvard University Press, [While the Women Only Wept](#) and [Minding the Public Purse](#). She also sits on the board of directors of the Canada West Foundation in Calgary and was recently appointed to the National Task Force on Financial Literacy.
