Yves Rabeau holds a Master's degree in Commerce from HEC Montréal and a Ph.D. in economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). He is a full professor of management and economics at the École des sciences de la gestion of the Université du Québec à Montréal (ESG-UQAM). Dr. Rabeau's teaching and research focus on telecommunications and the media as well as on innovation and the emergence of new business models.
